He's going to go check out the helicopters and the tanks.

Wow. Ok, ear plugs mandatory. This one's really loud. It does about 450-600 rounds per minute. Yikes. It shoots accurately at about 2000 yards.

So basically you can just stay in this area here. This place is huge. There's so much more that I can't see than I...what I can see. Oh, what is this? That is a drone. Let's check out this drone here. Look at this thing. So cool. That must be the camera down there. How fast is this...does the drone go? This one will fly up to 110 knots. And what kind of range does it have? We can get up to 100 miles away with this. Before you've got to come back? Yup. Flight time is nine hours. Wow. It 15 gallons of fuel in the wings.
