Another reason why we're fortunate is because this hotel allows food delivery. Not a lot of quarantine hotels do. So we can get food delivery twice a day for lunch and for dinner. People can send us stuff. We've had people send us a bunch of toys for Little Mike to play with, which has been awesome. And a bunch of like instant noodles and dried stuff, noodles like that. We can't actually cook anything in here. They won't allow us to buy any cooking stuff because it's a danger. We have a hot water pot, so for breakfast, we've just been boiling eggs that we bought. I guess we've got to get this day started. Shower up. Another interesting day in paradise.

[00:02:34] Throw it away. Good job. Did you find your car? Yeah, that's the car we made together.

[00:02:44] Yeah, you painted it. That was your Christmas gift. We made it in quarantine. This is the car that Little Mike painted. You can see it's so beautiful. Uh oh, did it brake? Oh, no!

I was worried about laundry, but honestly, no need to change clothes that often. They did give us this soap, which you can use to wash your clothes with. I guess we just got to do it the old fashioned way.

Yeah. Here's his little potty. We decided while we're in here, we're going to potty train him. So that's been going really well. There's been a few accidents on the floor. You need to peepee? We got one of these for him to poop in. Hopefully, by the time we get out of quarantine, he'll be fully potty trained. Right, buddy?

[00:03:45] I need to shave. Should I shave? I might just wait until after quarantine, see how long it gets. I don't know. You may be wondering why I'm wearing this kind of a shirt. Well, for some reason, this room stays extremely warm. Even in the middle of winter, we've not had to use our heater one time. Even though I had, like, record cold, like -8C, it was still just so warm in here.
